



Player, Parent & Coach Code of Conduct

As a member of Brownsburg Lacrosse, I will...

1. Know the rules and abide by them.
2. Emphasize the value of good sportsmanship, the concepts of fair play and the skills of the game over the outcome of the game.
3. Respect all involved with the sport of lacrosse, including:
 - a. the game officials, refraining from addressing them (players) or commenting on their decisions during the play of the game (coaches);
 - b. spectators;
 - c. coaches and players of the opposing team and demonstrate appropriate gestures of sportsmanship at the conclusion of a game. I will be humble and generous in victory and proud and courteous in defeat; and
 - d. all Brownsburg lacrosse staff & board.
4. Maintain control of my emotions, avoiding the use of abusive language or profanity, humiliating remarks, gestures of ill temper, and threatened or actual physical assault upon teammates, opponents, coaches, referees or spectators at any time.
5. Follow all facility & field rules and regulations, respecting at all times the property of others.
6. Attend every practice and game as is reasonably possible, notifying the coach in advance if unable to attend.
7. Abide by the Two-Two Rule: no fewer than 2 adults will be present at all times when 2 or fewer players are present.
8. Not solicit Brownsburg Lacrosse members for unsanctioned fee-for-service activities, even if related to lacrosse. Examples include but are not limited to: off-season personal training, nutrition planning, & supplements
9. Follow the Social Media Policy Addendum, attached as page 3.
10. Abide by the Code of Conduct throughout the year, not simply during the season, understanding that It is only through such conduct that our sport can earn and maintain a positive image and make its full contribution to youth sports.

I understand that any actual or alleged violation of any item in the Code of Conduct will be reviewed by coaching staff (player issue) and/or Board of Directors (coach or parent issue). The Board has final discretion on consequences, which may range from verbal reprimand to removal from team (player or coach) or ban from attending Brownsburg Lacrosse events (parent).

Social Media Policy Addendum

This Social Media Policy is an addendum to the Brownsburg Lacrosse Code of Conduct, and incorporated therein.

Social media can be a useful tool to communicate with teammates, fans, friends, coaches and more.

Social media can also be dangerous if you are not careful. Every picture, link, quote, tweet, status, or post that you put online is forever part of your digital footprint.

You never know when that will come back to hurt or help your reputation during the recruiting process, a new job, or other important areas of your life.

Recognizing the above, all players, coaches and board members of Brownsburg Lacrosse shall:

- take responsibility for their online profile, including posts and any photos, videos or other recordings posted by others in which they appear.
- post only positive things about teammates, coaches, opponents (players & coaches) and officials.

- not retaliate about negative comments posted online, and will report any comment that makes them feel uncomfortable to a person in position of authority.
